

A survey about play equipment in Portishead

What is this about?

£30,000 of funding for play equipment is currently available from Portishead Town Council who planned to install 4 new pieces of play equipment at the Lake Grounds playpark.

However, North Somerset Council - as landlord of the Lake Grounds - have refused consent to place new play equipment at the Lake Grounds in Portishead because they state that the Lake Grounds playpark is already 'adequately equipped'.

A number of Portishead residents have decided to question this refusal of consent and we want to find out what other Portishead residents think about this.

Who is organising it?

The study is being organised voluntarily by a group of Portishead residents. No one is being paid to organise it and it is not associated with either North Somerset or Portishead Town Councils.

Are there any disadvantages of taking part?

What will happen to the results of the study?

We will share what we find out with Portishead Town Council and North Somerset Council and might use the results to help try and influence them to invest the existing funding in play equipment in Portishead. We will **not** release your personal information to **anyone**.
